Station or zone is synonymous

NODE timers have more than one program: A, B, and C

Write the start time # and start time(s) here like: *1 - 5:00am, 2 - 12:00pm*

Write the run time for each station/zone here like: *30 mins*.

Circle the water days

You can adjust the global run time (across all stations/zones) using this feature.
Be sure to momentarily change this to 100% EVERY time you individually change a single station/zone then put the SA back where you want it

It's best to use compass locations in your descriptions such as *front lawn W* or *back beds E*

Most properties have more than one location for the sprinkler valves such as front and back yard. You can use *A, B, C* here

This helps when it's time to service and repair them. An example here is *Hunter ASV - 101*
