Use this sheet to help decide how to program the timer(s) and to keep record. Only fill in above what you wish.

- Timer locations      Some properties have more than one timer. Write this as *in garage* or *in back patio*
- Property              If you own more than one property, use one sheet per property
- Program                Most timers have more than one program available such as A, B, and C
- Watering location    It's best to use compass locations in your descriptions such as *front lawn W* or *back beds E*
- Valve location #      Most properties have more than one location for the sprinkler valves such as front and back yard. You can use *A, B, C* here
- Valve brand and model This helps when it's time to service and repair them. An example here is *Hunter ASV - 101*
- Date valve replaced   This helps, in part, for warranty purposes
- Diaphragm replaced   Write the date it was replaced. This helps keep things in perspective if problems occur
- Start times              Write the program number(s) and time(s) here like: *A 5am*
- Water days              Circle the water days
